Three exciting tournaments are planned for the Pickwick's 2022 golf season. Our tournaments require a USGA Handicap Index. The entry deadline for tournaments this season is May 15, 2022

- 1. Club Championship & 1ST Flight: Beginning on June 1, 2022, an 18-hole match play tournament will be played in flights determined by handicap, but match play tournament hole scores are not adjusted for handicap (i.e. a "scratch" tournament). All matches are to be played from the proper tees Ladies Forward tees, White (regular) tees Men with handicap index below 16.1, Yellow tees handicap index 16.1 or above.

 There is no entry fee for this tournament.
- 2. **Seniors Tournament:** Beginning May 20, 2022, a 9-hole match play tournament in which one-half of a player's 18-hole handicap applies, but no more than one stroke per hole. Players must be 55 years of age prior to the start date of this tournament. All matches are to be played from proper tees Ladies forward tees, Men yellow tees. **Entry fee for this tournament is \$10.00.**
- 3. **Wild Goose Chase:** Beginning May 20, 2022 an 18-hole match play tournament with full handicap, but no more than one stroke per hole. Ladies will play from the forward tees. Men with handicap index below 16.1 will play from the white tees. Participants handicap index 16.1 or above, may play from the yellow tees. **Entry fee for this tournament is \$15.00.**
